## What is the Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP)?

The Marine Corps EFMP is a mandatory program designed to coordinate PCS assignments for active duty sponsors who have family members with qualifying medical or educational needs. EFMP PCS assignment coordination ensures the availability and accessibility of necessary medical and educational services for these family members.

Ensuring continuity of care for exceptional family members enhances the quality of life for enrolled Marine Corps families in order to support the mission of the Marine Corps.

## How Do I Enroll?

### Complete



DD Form 2792  
(Medical Summary)



DD Form 2792-1  
(Special Education/ Early Intervention Summary, if applicable)

Return forms to EFMP office for processing.



### Who Qualifies?



Any Family member who is enrolled in DEERS, MCTFS, resides with the sponsor, and has a qualifying medical or educational need.



### Benefits of Enrolling?

- Assigned a Family Case Worker
- Assignment coordination
- Relocation assistance
- Eligibility for respite care reimbursement
- Workshops and trainings
- Support at IEP meetings
- EFMP attorney assistance
- Special housing considerations, based on medical necessity
- Resources, referrals, and more!
