## Introduction to EFMP

**MARINE & Family** | Exceptional Family Member Program

**Will enrolling in EFMP restrict where I can be assigned and hinder my career advancement?**

Service members enrolled in EFMP receive consideration equal to all others for assignments and promotions.

**Does being enrolled mean I cannot get stationed overseas ?**

No, EFMP enrollment does not prohibit overseas assignments. The assignment will be to a pinpoint location that has been coordinated with the medical activity and the DoD school system when special education or early intervention services are required.

**Can any dependent be enrolled?**

Dependents living with the service member who are enrolled in DEERS and MCTFS can include a spouse, child or dependent adult, regardless of age, with a special medical/mental health need OR a child, birth through age 21, with a special education need.

**Does my Spouse's Command have specific information about our enrollment?**

The CO can request a roster of Marines enrolled in EFMP. The roster contains only sponsor name, when EFMP enrollment began, and when update is due. Marines do not have to disclose medical information about a family member to the command.
